Museums, art supply stores, and libraries offer many classes, but few are tailored to the needs of those who "can't draw a stick figure". These safe, welcoming spaces have an air of encouragement, step- by-step guides, and one-on-one coaching all within a group setting.

It has been a privilege to witness beautiful creations unfold as individuals move beyond their limiting beliefs. We learn together there is no such thing as a "non-artist", only artists that have something in their way. I'd love to partner with your community to break down barriers and heal these creative wounds, fostering an environment where creative expression triumphs over competition. I believe that in today's world, nothing is more important than compassion and innovative thinking, and the arts hold the key to driving meaningful change for both current and future generations.





Color Our World: Programs for Children

Model Magic Moments: A Sensory Art Adventure (K-3) Join us for a fun and engaging sensory experience designed for little hands and big imaginations! In this playful workshop, children will color Model Magic clay using Crayola markers, knead it to blend vibrant colors, and craft their very own snail and rose creations. These delightful projects will harden within 24 hours, becoming cherished keepsakes to enjoy and display. Under-the-Sea Rainbow Collage (K-3) Let's create a vibrant collage using tissue paper and ocean-themed templates! Children can choose from fish, seahorse, or dolphin designs as the base for their artwork. They'll tear or cut colorful tissue paper into small pieces and glue them onto their chosen template, arranging the colors in a rainbow pattern or any design they like. This hands-on activity fosters fine motor skills, color recognition, and creative expression while introducing kids to sea life. The finished pieces are a lively celebration of underwater magic and make for a beautiful home display.	\$300 up to 12 families
Art for the Budding Naturalist: Mixed-Media Monarch Painting (ages 6-10) This engaging art activity invites children aged 6-10 to explore the fascinating world of monarch butterflies through creative expression. We'll will use acrylic paints in vibrant orange and white on striking black paper to paint monarch butterflies, learning about their unique life cycle and metamorphosis along the way. The workshop will incorporate educational elements about the importance of monarchs and their role in pollination, while children create their own color pencil garden to create a setting for their painted Monarchs. This hands-on activity fosters creativity, environmental awareness, and an appreciation for one of nature's most iconic species.	\$350 up to 12 families

Guided, step-by-step instruction will help participants pair and layer images to craft unique designs. Attendees will experiment with a variety of ink types and stamping methods, culminating in a finished piece of art and a handmade bookmark to take home. Watercolor Pencil 101 Watercolor pencil provides participants with the color of dry media, but the beauty and delicacy of watercolor.
